ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Revocations—The principal order is hereby amended, as from its commencement, by revoking clauses 3 (1), 4, and 5 (a).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes certain increases to prescribed amounts included in the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order 1979, which amounts exceed the increases allowed under the Accident Compensation Act 1972.
