**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of December 1981

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Prescribed Amounts) Order (No. 2) 1981.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Interpretation**—In this order the expression “the Act” means the Accident Compensation Act 1972.

**3. Application**—(1) For the purposes of clause 4 of this order, this order shall not apply to—

(a) Earnings as an employee paid on or before the 31st day of March 1982:

(b) Earnings as a self-employed person derived during the financial year ending on or before the 30th day of September 1981.

(2) For the purposes of clause 5 of this order, this order shall apply for the purpose of calculating earnings related compensation payable for any period of incapacity which occurs on or after the 16th day of December 1981, whether the accident occurred before, on, or after that date.

**4. Prescribing increased amount for the purposes of section 74—**Subject to clause 3 (1) of this order, for the purposes of section 74 of the Act, the prescribed amount shall be \$39,000.

**5. Prescribing increased amount for the purposes of sections 113 and 118 of the Act—**Subject to clause 3 (2) of this order,—

- (a) For the purposes of section 113 of the Act, the prescribed amount shall be \$600:
- (b) For the purposes of section 118 of the Act, the prescribed amount shall be \$190, but subject to the power of the Accident Compensation Corporation to increase this amount within the limits specified in section 118 (5) of the Act.
