ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 15th day of June 1992

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1982, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Increased Amounts) Order (No. 2) 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In this order—

“The Act” means the Accident Compensation Act 1982:

“Prescribed date” means the 3rd day of June 1992.

3. Assessment of permanent incapacity—In any case where earnings related compensation is payable in respect of permanent loss of earning capacity fixed by or derived from an assessment under section 60 of the Act as a result of an accident that occurred on or before the 31st day of

December 1991, the amount of that compensation is hereby increased on and after the prescribed date by 1 percent.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases, by 1 percent, the amount of earnings related compensation payable for permanent incapacity in respect of accidents occurring on or before 31 December 1991. The increase applies to compensation payable on or after 3 June 1992.
