THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS (PARATHION AND PARATHION-METHYL) NOTICE 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968*, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals (Parathion and Parathion-methyl) Notice 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Chemicals (Parathion and Parathion-methyl) Notice 1971† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date

of its notification in the Gazette.

2. Parathion or Parathion-methyl in pellets—Clause 3 of the principal notice is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

"(g) The substance may be applied to carrots and parsnips for field evaluation against carrot weevil, and when so used-"(i) The pellets must be applied as a broadcast treatment prior to sowing the crop;

"(ii) After application the pellets must be incorporated

immediately into the soil; and

"(iii) Not more than 3 lbs active ingredient per acre may be applied."
