ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 (1) (f) of the Accident Compensation Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Dentists Costs) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Dentists Costs) Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- **2. Goods and services tax**—Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding, as subclause (2), the following subclause:

"(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1) of this regulation, where any amount is to be calculated in a manner that involves the deduction of any Social Security benefit, the full amount of that benefit, including any goods and services tax component, shall be deducted."

Accident Compensation (Dentists Costs) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations clarify the situation concerning deduction of Social Security benefits when calculating amounts under the regulations. The goods and services tax component of the Social Security benefit is also to be deducted.
