PURSUANT to section 120(1)(f) of the Accident Compensation Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Pharmaceutical Costs) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Pharmaceutical Costs) Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Costs payable where pharmaceutical item ordered by medical practitioner or dentist in employ of Crown or area health board— Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The effect of these regulations is to require the Corporation to pay the charges for pharmaceutical items prescribed by medical practitioners and dentists acting in the employment of the Crown or area health boards on the same basis as it is required to pay those charges for items prescribed by other medical practitioners and dentists.
