PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1987, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1989.
- **2. Schedule**—(1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the new Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.
- (2) The Accident Compensation Employers and Self-Employed Persons Levies Order 1987, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.
