**THE ALIEN CONTROL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT No. 1.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 27th day of
October, 1939.

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Alien Control Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Alien Control Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting next after Regulation 23 thereof the following heading and regulation :—

“MOVEMENTS OF ALIEN ENEMIES.

“23A. (1) Every alien who is or at any time has been a national of any State with which His Majesty is at war shall before leaving his registered place of abode for the time being for any continuous period exceeding twenty-four hours obtain from a Registration Officer in the Police District in which he resides a written permit authorizing him to be so absent.

“ (2) Upon applying for a permit under this regulation the applicant shall supply such details of his intended absence and of the reason therefor as the Registration Officer may require.

“ (3) A permit under this regulation may be subject to such conditions as the officer who issues it thinks advisable, and may relate to one occasion or to a series of occasions or to a specified period of time.

“(4) Any permit under this regulation may at any time be revoked by notice in writing signed by a Registration Officer and delivered to the person to whom the permit was issued and when so revoked shall no longer be of any force or effect.

“(5) Every alien to whom a permit has been issued under this regulation shall on the expiry or revocation thereof forthwith deliver the same to a Registration Officer in the Police District in which he resides.

“(6) No person to whom this regulation applies shall be absent from his registered place of abode for any continuous period exceeding twenty-four hours except in accordance with the terms of a permit issued under this regulation.”

4. Regulation 24 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting after the words “ wharves or shipping ” the following additional words: “ or permit to be absent from a registered place of abode.”

5. Regulation 26 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting after the words “ change of abode ” the following additional words: “ or permit to be absent from a registered place of abode.”
