THE ALIEN CONTROL EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 2.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 22nd day of November, 1939.

Present :

THE HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Alien Control Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Alien Control Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. Regulation 25 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following additional clauses :---

"(3) Except as provided in the next succeeding clause hereof, these regulations shall not apply to persons of the following classes, namely—

- "(a) Any person who became a naturalized British subject (whether in New Zealand or elsewhere) at any time before the 4th day of August, 1914, and who has not at any time since naturalization ceased to be a British subject, notwithstanding that such person may be an alien as defined in these regulations:
- "(b) Any person born within His Majesty's dominions and allegiance whose parents became naturalized British subjects (whether in New Zealand or elsewhere) at any time before the 4th day of August, 1914, and who has not at any time ceased to be a British subject, notwithstanding that by reason of his birth before the naturalization of his parents such person may be an alien as defined in these regulations :
- "(c) Any person born in New Zealand within His Majesty's allegiance who has been continuously resident in New Zealand for the whole of his life.

"(4) Nevertheless, the Minister may by notice under his hand delivered to the person concerned direct that these regulations shall apply from the time of service of the notice to any such person as is described in the last preceding clause hereof.

"(5) A notice given under the last preceding clause hereof shall not prevent in respect of the person concerned the exercise of the powers conferred by clauses (1) and (2) of this regulation."
