At the Government House at Wellington this 9th day of August 1976 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its

notification in the Gazette.

2. Classification of earners for levy purposes—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the items set out in the Schedule hereto.
