PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and recommencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1979.

2. Classification of earners for levy purposes and rates of levy—(1) The principal order is hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as amended by clause 2 of the Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the new Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.

(2) The Accident Compensation Earners' Scheme Levies Order 1973, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.
