THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS (EXEMPTION FROM REGISTRATION) NOTICE 1970

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959, the Minister of Agriculture, acting on the recommendation of the Agricultural Chemicals Board, hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals (Exemption from Registration) Notice 1970.

(2) This notice shall come into force 7 days after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Chemicals exempted from registration—Every agricultural chemical consisting of or containing—

(a) Any of the chemical elements set out in the Schedule hereto; or

(b) Any chemical compound containing any such element; or

(c) Any preparation containing any such element or compound—
is hereby exempted from the provisions of section 12 of the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959, if it is sold or used for the purpose of plant nutrition and not for any other purpose that would bring it within the definition of an agricultural chemical within the meaning of that Act:

Provided that the exemption shall not apply to any preparation containing any such element or compound if it also contains any other agricultural chemical that is not exempted from the provisions of the said section 12.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This notice exempts certain specified chemicals, when sold or used as plant nutrients, from registration under section 12 of the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959.
