HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Accident Compensation Act 1972, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Permanent Incapacity) Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1975.

2. Increase in amounts payable—Amounts payable in respect of permanent loss of earning capacity at the commencement of this order and fixed by or derived from an assessment under section 114 of the Accident Compensation Act 1972 are hereby increased by an amount equal to 9 percent of those amounts.
