

THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS (INSECTICIDES) NOTICE 1962

Pursuant to regulation 5 of the Agricultural Chemicals (Insecticides) Regulations 1961,* the Director-General of Agriculture hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. This notice may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals (Insecticides) Notice 1962.
- 2. For the purposes of this notice, the term "pasture" includes any fodder crop, and any seed crop the straw of which is intended as food for stock.
- 3. The insecticides specified in the Schedule hereto may, if registered under the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959, be applied to pasture on the terms and conditions specified in the said Schedule in respect of those insecticides, but not otherwise.
