THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS (FENSULFOTHION)  
NOTICE 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968\*, the Director-General of Agriculture hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals (Fensulfothion) Notice 1971, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Chemicals (Fensulfothion) Notice 1971† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Fensulfothion as a liquid**—(1) Clause 6 of the principal notice is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (d) the words “6 weeks”, and substituting the words “4 weeks”.

(2) The said clause 6 is hereby further amended by omitting paragraph (e), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(e) Not more than 1 lb active ingredient of fensulfothion which is undiluted shall be applied per acre to any area in any period of 2 months:”.
