**THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS (FENSULFOTHION)  
NOTICE 1971, AMENDMENT NO. 2**

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968\*, the Director-General of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives the following notice.

**NOTICE**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals (Fensulfothion) Notice 1971, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Chemicals (Fensulfothion) Notice 1971† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Amendment to Schedule**—The Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by adding the following items:

“Boysenberries	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.
Raspberries	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.
Loganberries	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.
Blackcurrants	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.
Redcurrants	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.
Gooseberries	.....	20 lbs	Between March 1 and August 31.”
