

THE ACCIDENT COMPENSATION (HYPERBARIC OXYGEN TREATMENT COSTS) REGULATIONS 1989, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 (1) (f) of the Accident Compensation Act 1982, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Costs) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Costs) Regulations 1989* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Corporation to pay certain costs**—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (3), the following subclause:

"(3A) The Corporation shall not pay any costs unless it has been advised of the date on which the treatment was provided, and the specific nature of the treatment."

3. New Schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the new Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

COSTS PAYABLE BY CORPORATION IN RESPECT OF HYPERBARIC OXYGEN
TREATMENT PROVIDED BY HMNZS PHILOMEL

The costs payable by the Corporation for hyperbaric oxygen treatment provided by HMNZS Philomel is the amount that would have been charged to the claimant if the treatment were one for which the Corporation was not making a payment (less any Social Security benefit) or the amount specified below (less any Social Security benefit), whichever is the lesser:

1. Neurological assay before recompression	 	100
2. Neurological assay after recompression	 	90
3. In-chamber treatment supervision, per hour	 	102
4. Out-of-chamber treatment supervision, per hour	 	50"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, increase the maximum amounts payable under the principal regulations in respect of in-chamber and out-of-chamber treatment supervision, and provide that the Accident Compensation Corporation is not to pay any costs unless it has been advised of the date of treatment and the specific nature of the treatment.
