ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 120 (1) (f) of the Accident Compensation Act 1982, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Costs) Regulations 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Costs) Regulations 1990* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1992.

2. Corporation to pay certain costs—Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$67.50”, and substituting the expression “\$57.40”.

3. New schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

4. Saving—Notwithstanding regulations 2 and 3 of these regulations, where hyperbaric oxygen treatment has been provided at any time in the period beginning on the 15th day of October 1990 and ending with the close of the 31st day of January 1992, at HMNZS Philomel in respect of personal injury by accident, the principal regulations shall be read as if the amendments made by regulations 2 and 3 of these regulations had not been made.

**COSTS PAYABLE BY CORPORATION IN RESPECT OF HYPERBARIC OXYGEN
TREATMENT PROVIDED AT HMNZS PHILOMEL**

The costs payable by the Corporation for hyperbaric oxygen treatment provided at HMNZS Philomel is the amount that would have been charged to the claimant if the treatment were one for which the Corporation was not making a payment (less any Social Security benefit) or the amount specified below (less any Social Security benefit) whichever is the lesser:

2. Neurological assay after recompression	86.05	
3. In-chamber treatment supervision, per hour	97.55	
4. Out-of-chamber treatment supervision, per hour	47.80”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Accident Compensation (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Costs) Regulations 1990, with effect on and after 1 February 1992, by reducing the maximum amounts that the Corporation may pay in respect of hyperbaric oxygen treatment provided at HMNZS Philomel by 15 percent.
