



**THE AGRICULTURAL CHEMICALS REGULATIONS 1968,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

PURSUANT to the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Herbicides in oil—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 14, and substituting the following regulation:

“14. No person shall at any time apply or cause to be applied any herbicide, either undiluted or diluted with oil, in the form of an oil-soluble ester or in the form of an emulsifiable ester or acid to any land or pasture or plant life—

“(a) Within 5 miles of a vineyard, if applied from an aircraft or by an airblast sprayer; or

“(b) Within 1 mile of a vineyard, if applied by any other means.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 14 of the principal regulations provides that no herbicide in the form of an oil-soluble ester or in the form of an emulsifiable ester or acid mixed with oil with aromatic content is to be applied within a specified distance of a vineyard.

This provision applies only to herbicides diluted with oil. These regulations extend the provision so that it will apply to undiluted herbicides also.
