PURSUANT to the Agricultural Chemicals Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Application fees—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting the expression "\$6" in both places where it occurs, and substituting the expression "\$30":
- (b) By omitting the expression "50c" in both places where it occurs, and substituting the expression "\$2":
- (c) By omitting the expression "\$1", and substituting the expression "\$5".

3. Amendment of First Schedule—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the item "Triclopyr".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 increases the fees for registration of agricultural chemicals under the Agricultural Chemicals Regulations 1968 as follows—

- (a) The fees payable on applications for full registration and for provisional registration are increased from \$6 to \$30 and 50c to \$2 respectively:
- (b) The fee payable for registration of a changed agricultural chemical is increased from 50c to \$2:
- (c) The fee payable for full registration in cases where previously a full fee has been paid but only provisional registration obtained is increased from \$1 to \$5.

The effect of regulation 3 is to include the chemical "Triclopyr" in the definition of "herbicide" in the principal regulations.
