

# THE ACCIDENT COMPENSATION (DENTAL SPECIALISTS COSTS) REGULATIONS (NO. 2) 1990, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 120 (1) (f) of the Accident Compensation Act 1982, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Accident Compensation (Dental Specialists Costs) Regulations (No. 2) 1990, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation (Dental Specialists Costs) Regulations (No. 2) 1990\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1992.
- 2. New Schedule substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

**3. Saving**—Notwithstanding regulation 2 of these regulations, where a registered specialist has provided, at any time in the period beginning on the 15th day of October 1990 and ending with the close of the 31st day of January 1992, treatment in respect of personal injury by accident, the principal regulations shall be read as if the amendment made by regulation 2 of these regulations had not been made.

Where the claimant has a pre-existing malocclusion the amount payable by the Corporation shall be reduced by the amount that the registered specialist would have charged the claimant for orthodontic treatment if the claimant had not suffered the personal injury by accident and had elected to have treatment for the malocclusion."

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Accident Compenstion (Dental Specialists Costs) Regulations (No. 2) 1990, with effect on and from 1 February 1992, by reducing the maximum amounts that the Corporation may pay in respect of treatments provided by registered dental specialists by 15 percent.
