At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of June 1978

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 24 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Animals Diseases Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Bovine malignant catarrh and mucosal disease complex—The Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby amended by omitting the words “bovine malignant catarrh” and “mucosal disease complex”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order amends the Animals Act 1967 by omitting bovine malignant catarrh and mucosal disease complex from the Second Schedule (which specifies diseases to which the Act applies).
