ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of August 1980

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 24 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Animals (Fish) Diseases Order 1980.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Diseases of fish**—The Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby amended by adding, after the name of the disease called “Warbles”, the following heading and names of diseases:

*“Diseases of Fish*

- Aeromonas salmonicida (furunculosis)
- Infectious haematopoietic necrosis (IHN)
- Infectious pancreatic necrosis (IPN)
- Myxosoma cerebralis (whirling disease)
- Spring viraemia of carp (SVC)
- Viral haemorrhagic septicaemia (VHS)
- Yersinia ruckeri (enteric redmouth disease)”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order makes the diseases set out in clause 2 of the order Second Schedule diseases for the purposes of the Animals Act 1967. If any animal is believed to be suffering from a Second Schedule disease various control measures may be taken under that Act.
