ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 23rd day of March 1992

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 24 of the Animals Act 1967, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Animals Diseases Order 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. First Schedule diseases—(1) The First Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical order, the names of the diseases “Equine influenza” and “Peste de petits ruminants”.

(2) The said First Schedule is hereby further amended by omitting the name of the disease “Scrapie”.

3. Second Schedule diseases—The Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby amended by inserting, in their appropriate alphabetical

order, the names of the diseases, "Brucella abortus", "Infectious bursal disease", and "Spongiform encephalopathy".

4. Diseases of fish—The Second Schedule to the Animals Act 1967 is hereby further amended by inserting under the heading, "*Diseases of Fish*", after the name of the disease "*Aeromonas salmonicida* (furunculosis)", the name of the disease "Bonamia sp."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the Animals Act 1967—

- (a) By adding the diseases, Equine influenza, and Peste de petits ruminants to the list of First Schedule diseases:
- (b) By omitting the disease, Scrapie, from the list of First Schedule diseases:
- (c) By adding the diseases, Brucella abortus, Infectious bursal disease, and Spongiform encephalopathy to the list of Second Schedule diseases:
- (d) By adding the disease Bonamia sp. to the list of diseases of fish set out in the Second Schedule.
