## THE ANNIVERSARY DAY OBSERVANCE EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 10th day of January, 1942.

## Present:

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Anniversary Day Observance Emergency Regulations 1942.
- 2. In these regulations the term "Anniversary Day" includes the day observed or to be observed as Anniversary Day in any provincial district in the year 1942.
- 8. Where in any Act or in any award or industrial agreement under the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1925, or in any agreement under the Labour Disputes Investigation Act, 1913, or in any voluntary agreement relating to terms of employment of any workers, provision exists, applicable to Anniversary Day in either of the Provincial Districts of Auckland and Wellington, for the granting of a holiday or the observance of particular hours of labour on that day, such provision shall have no application to such Anniversary Day in the year 1942.
- 4. Nevertheless, if in any such Act, award, or agreement as aforesaid provision exists, applicable to work performed on such Anniversary Day as aforesaid, for payment of special rates of wages or for other special benefit, then subject to the

Overtime and Holidays Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1941,\* such provision shall continue to have full effect in the year 1942, and such special rate of wages shall accordingly be paid or such other special benefit be granted.

5. It shall be lawful for the Minister of Labour from time

5. It shall be lawful for the Minister of Labour from time to time by notice under his hand published in the *Gazette* to declare that these regulations shall apply to the Anniversary Day of the year 1942 in any other provincial district.
