**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 10th day of March 1980

PURSUANT to section 21A of the Machinery Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1980.

**2. Applications for registration**—Regulation 4 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) A fee of \$15; and”.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1980, increase the fee payable biennially for the registration of an amusement device from \$10 to \$15.
