

# THE AMUSEMENT DEVICES REGULATIONS 1978, AMENDMENT NO. 1

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 10th day of March 1980

PURSUANT to section 21a of the Machinery Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Amusement Devices Regulations 1978\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1980.
- 2. Applications for registration—Regulation 4 (4) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

"(a) A fee of \$15; and".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1980, increase the fee payable biennially for the registration of an amusement device from \$10 to \$15.
