HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Aliens Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Aliens Emergency Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) The principal regulations shall hereafter be administered by such Minister of the Crown as may from time to time be charged with the administration thereof, and the Minister so charged shall, in relation to his functions under the said regulations, be known as the Minister in Charge of Aliens.
- (2) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from subclause (1) thereof the definition of the term "Minister", and substituting the following definition:—
 - "' Minister' means the Minister in Charge of Aliens:".
