ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 6th day of April 1970

PURSUANT to the Navy Act 1954, the New Zealand Army Act 1950, and the Royal New Zealand Air Force Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1970.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. Equivalent ranks in the Armed Forces—For the purposes of the Navy Act 1954, the New Zealand Army Act 1950, and the Royal New Zealand Air Force Act 1950, the equivalent relative ranks of men and women members of the New Zealand Naval Forces, the New Zealand Army, and the Royal New Zealand Air Force are those specified in the Schedule to this order.

3. Revocation—The Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1966* is hereby revoked.
