HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Navy Act 1954, the New Zealand Army Act 1950, and the Royal New Zealand Air Force Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1970, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1970* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Equivalent ranks of Naval Warrant Officer—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended:

- (a) By omitting the words “No equivalent” under the heading “New Zealand Naval Forces” “*Ratings*” in column 1, and substituting the words “Warrant Officer”;
- (b) By omitting the words “No equivalent” under the headings “Women’s Royal New Zealand Naval Service” “*Ratings*” in column 4, and substituting the words “Warrant Officer Wren”;
- (c) By omitting the words “Junior to Air Force Warrant Officer and Master Aircrew” which appear in the footnotes to that Schedule and substituting the words “Junior to Naval Warrant Officer, Air Force Warrant Officer, and Master Aircrew”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order incorporates the new rank of Warrant Officer in the New Zealand Naval Forces and the Women's Royal New Zealand Naval Service into the table of equivalent ranks contained in the Schedule to the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1970.
