PURSUANT to section 9 of the Defence Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1983, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Equivalent Ranks Order 1983* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Equivalent ranks of Leading Rank—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting from item 17 in the table of equivalent ranks the words "(but junior to Army and Air Force ranks)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order omits a reference that was included erroneously in the principal order. While historically correct, the reference is not applicable under the Armed Forces Discipline Act 1971.
