

## THE ARMED FORCES ESTABLISHMENTS ROAD TRAFFIC BYLAWS 1970, AMENDMENT NO. 2

PURSUANT to section 72 of the Transport Act 1962, the Minister of Defence, being the Minister having the control of the roads within the bounds of the Establishments specified in the First Schedule to the principal bylaws, hereby makes the following bylaws.

## **BYLAWS**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These bylaws may be cited as the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Bylaws 1970, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Armed Forces Establishments Road Traffic Bylaws 1970\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal bylaws).
- (2) These bylaws shall come into force on the date of their notification in the Gazette.

2. Armed forces establishments—The First Schedule to the principal

- bylaws is hereby amended—

  (a) By omitting from the part thereof relating to the Navy the item relating to the Naval W.T. Station, Waiaruhe, and substituting the following item:

  "Naval W.T. Station ....... Waiouru":
  - (b) By omitting from the part thereof relating to the Army the following items:

    "Ammunition Depot ...... Belmont, Wellington.
    - "Ammunition Depot ...... Mt. Somers, Canterbury."

      "Ammunition Depot ...... Glentunnel, Canterbury."
- 3. Special speed limits—The Second Schedule to the principal bylaws is hereby amended by omitting from the part thereof relating to the Army the item relating to the Army Camp, Fort Cautley, Devonport, and substituting the following item:

"Army Camp, Fort Cautley, All roads ...... 10"
