# THE AIR FORCE PAY AND ALLOWANCES NOTICE 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 3

Pursuant to regulation 31a of the Air Force Regulations 1952,\* the Minister of Defence, with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, hereby gives the following notice.

#### NOTICE

- 1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Air Force Pay and Allowances Notice 1960, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Air Force Pay and Allowances Notice 1960† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).
- (2) This notice shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1961.
- 2. (1) The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by subclause (1) of clause 2 of the Air Force Pay and Allowances Notice 1960, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.
- (2) Clause 2 of the Air Force Pay and Allowances Notice 1960, Amendment No. 2, is hereby revoked.
- 3. (1) The Second Schedule to the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking clause 11 (as substituted by subclause (1) of clause 5 of the Air Force Pay and Allowances Notice 1960, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following clause:
  - "11. Medical Officers: Daily rates of special allowance (regulations 79 and 147)—
