PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Artificial Insemination of Animals Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Artificial Insemination of Animals Regulations 1972* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule, and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
