PURSUANT to subsections (1) and (4) of section 164 of the Education Act 1989, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Auckland Institute of Technology Disestablishment and Incorporation into Auckland University of Technology Order 1999.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 January 2000.

**2. Auckland Institute of Technology disestablished and incorporated into Auckland University of Technology**—The polytechnic that, immediately before the commencement of this order, is known as the Auckland Institute of Technology—

- (a) Is disestablished; and
- (b) Is incorporated in the Auckland University of Technology.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 1 January 2000, disestablishes the Auckland Institute of Technology and incorporates it in the Auckland University of Technology, which was established by the Auckland University of Technology (Establishment) Order 1999.
