#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Auckland Institute of Technology Disestablishment and Incorporation into Auckland University of Technology Order 1999.
  - (2) This order comes into force on 1 January 2000.
- 2. Auckland Institute of Technology disestablished and incorporated into Auckland University of Technology—The polytechnic that, immediately before the commencement of this order, is known as the Auckland Institute of Technology—
