



ADMIRALTY (FEES) ORDER 1997

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 1st day of December 1997

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 11 (4) of the Admiralty Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Admiralty (Fees) Order 1997.

(2) This order comes into force on 1 January 1998.

2. Fees of Court—(1) The fee payable in respect of the filing of an application under rule 15 of the Admiralty Rules 1975 for the issue of a warrant of arrest is \$920.

(2) The fee payable in respect of the filing under rule 23 of the Admiralty Rules 1975 of a request for a commission for the appraisement and sale of any property is \$900.

(3) Except for the fees prescribed by subclauses (1) and (2), the fees payable in respect of proceedings in the High Court in its Admiralty jurisdiction are those prescribed by the High Court Fees Regulations 1997.

(4) The fees in respect of proceedings in a District Court in its Admiralty jurisdiction are those prescribed by the District Courts Fees Rules 1997.

3. Goods and services tax included—The fees prescribed by this order are inclusive of goods and services tax.

4. Revocation—The Admiralty (Fees) Order 1992* is consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into effect on 1 January 1998, increases fees of Court required to be paid in respect of proceedings in the Admiralty jurisdiction of the High Court and in the Admiralty jurisdiction exercised by District Courts.

The fee payable for filing an application for the issue of a warrant of arrest is increased from \$830 to \$920.

The fee payable for filing a request for a commission for the appraisalment and sale of any property is increased from \$800 to \$900.

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
