ORDER 1971**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of December 1971

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Antarctica Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

O R D E R

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Antarctica (Specially Protected Areas) Order 1971.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1972.

2. New specially protected area—Annex B to the Agreed Measures for the Conservation of Antarctic Fauna and Flora, set out in the Second Schedule to the Antarctica Act 1960 (as added by section 3 of the Antarctica Amendment Act 1970), is hereby amended by adding the item set out in the Schedule to this order.

16. Coppermine Peninsula, Robert Island. Lat. 62° 23' S, long. 59° 42' W.
