## THE ANIMALS PROTECTION (MUTTON BIRD) WARRANT 1947

B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows :—

1. This Warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection (Mutton Bird) Warrant 1947.
2. This Warrant shall take effect on the day following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
3. The Mutton Bird (*Puffinus griseus*) shall be protected in that part of New Zealand described in the Schedule hereto.

### SCHEDULE

THE whole of the mainland of Stewart Island or Rakiura, excepting only thereout all that area of land situate in Block X, Lords River District, commencing at a point at mean high-water mark on the coast-line of Coeey Cove in line with the southern boundary of Section 8, Block X, Lords River District; thence due east across a road reserve to and along the southern boundary of Section 8 aforesaid, across a road reserve to a point at mean high-water mark on the coast-line in line with the southern boundary of Section 8 aforesaid; thence in a southerly, westerly, and northerly direction generally along the mean high-water mark of the coast-line to the point of commencement.
