# **Order in Council**

#### Present:

Pursuant to section 166 of the Animal Products Act 1999, Her Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

# Regulations

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Animal Products (Fees, Charges, and Levies) Amendment Regulations 2006.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 July 2006.

### 3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Animal Products (Fees, Charges, and Levies) Regulations 2002.

### 4 Application

These regulations apply in relation to verification and other activities occurring on or after 1 July 2006.

# 5 When fees, charges, and levies payable

Regulation 5 is amended by inserting "and regulation 5AA" after "subclauses (2) and (3)".

# 6 New regulation 5AA inserted

The following regulation is inserted after regulation 5:

# "5AA Alternative payment of annual charge

- "(1) Despite anything in these regulations, the Director-General may, at the request of the person concerned, calculate an annual charge based on an estimate of the fees and charges set out in Schedule 1 that would be payable by the person for the year.
- "(2) The Director-General must notify the person in writing of the annual charge calculated.
- "(3) An annual charge calculated under this regulation—
  - "(a) is payable in equal monthly instalments by the 27th day of each month of the year to which it relates (or by the 27th day of the month following that in which the Director-General gives the person written notice of the calculation, if later); and
  - "(b) is to be subject at the end of the year concerned to reconciliation and an appropriate further payment or

refund once the level of the actual services provided is known."

#### 7 Schedule 1 amended

- (1) Part 4 of Schedule 1 is amended by omitting "\$0.54" and substituting "\$0.61".
- (2) Part 6 of Schedule 1 is amended by inserting the following definitions in Note 3 before the definition of circuit charges: "after-hours callout charges refer to charges payable for hours where a veterinary or non-veterinary verifier performs verification functions at any place or premises outside of normal agreed hours of work, and are chargeable for these hours in substitution for any establishment or circuit charges "breakfast shift refers to the situation where the verification functions carried out by a verifier in any day are commenced
- (3) Part 6 of Schedule 1 is amended by revoking item 1 (establishment charge) and item 2 (circuit charge) and substituting the items 1, 2, and 3 set out in the Schedule of these regulations.

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# **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 2006, amend the Animal Products (Fees, Charges, and Levies) Regulations 2002 to alter various verification charges and levies. New charges are provided for after-hours callouts for veterinary and non-veterinary verifiers.
