## THE ANIMALS PROTECTION (NATIVE FROGS) WARRANT 1948

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921–22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows :—

1. This warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection (Native Frogs) Warrant 1948.

2. This warrant shall take effect on the day following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. Native frogs (*Liopelma hamiltoni* and *Liopelma hochstetteri*) included in the First Schedule to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921–22, under the heading "Amphibia," shall cease to be included therein, and native frogs (all species of the genus *Liopelma*) shall be deemed to be included in the said First Schedule (animals absolutely protected throughout New Zealand) under the same heading.
