**THE ANIMALS PROTECTION (NATIVE FROGS)  
WARRANT 1948**

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows :—

1. This warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection (Native Frogs) Warrant 1948.

2. This warrant shall take effect on the day following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. Native frogs (*Liopelma hamiltoni* and *Liopelma hochstetteri*) included in the First Schedule to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, under the heading "Amphibia," shall cease to be included therein, and native frogs (all species of the genus *Liopelma*) shall be deemed to be included in the said First Schedule (animals absolutely protected throughout New Zealand) under the same heading.
