



**THE ANIMALS PROTECTION (CANADIAN GOOSE)
WARRANT 1945**

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General

PURSUANT to section eight of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows:—

1. This Warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection (Canadian Goose) Warrant 1945.
2. This Warrant shall take effect on the day following the date of notification thereof in the *Gazette*.
3. Canadian goose (*Branta canadensis*) shall, with respect to the South Canterbury Acclimatization District, cease to be included in the Second Schedule to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22.
