**THE ANTHRAX PREVENTION REGULATIONS 1951,
AMENDMENT NO. 3.**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of August 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Health Act 1956, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Anthrax Prevention Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Anthrax Prevention Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "Japan".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Japan is now omitted from the list of countries specified in the Schedule to the principal regulations, from which direct importation of certain articles is prohibited. These articles may now be directly imported from Japan subject to the provisions of the principal regulations.
