



THE ANIMALS PROTECTION WARRANT 1944

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General

PURSUANT to section 3 of the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows :—

1. This Warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection Warrant 1944.
2. This Warrant shall take effect on and after the day following the date hereof.
3. Canadian goose (*Branta canadensis*) in the Ashburton Acclimatization District shall be deemed to cease to be included in the Second Schedule to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921-22.
