Pursuant to the Animals Protection and Game Act, 1921–22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows:—

- 1. This Warrant may be cited as the Animals Protection (Magpie) Warrant 1951.
- 2. This Warrant shall take effect on the day following the date of notification thereof in the Gazette.
- 3. The Magpie (Australian) (Gymnorhina tibicen) and the White-backed Magpie (Gymnorhina leuconota) shall be deemed to cease to be included in the First Schedule (animals absolutely protected).
