**THE ANIMALS QUARANTINE AND IMPORT INSPECTION
FEES REGULATIONS 1968, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of May 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fees and charges—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3, and substituting the following regulation:

“3. (1) Fees in respect of transport, sustenance, and care shall be payable as follows:

Foals born while in transit to New Zealand or in quarantine	1.75
Cattle	3.00
Calves born while in transit to New Zealand or in quarantine	1.75
Goats	1.50
Swine	1.50
Swine (sow plus litter)	2.50
Sheep	1.50
Lambs born while in transit to New Zealand or in quarantine	0.75
Dogs	1.50
Dogs—pups under 2 months old	0.75

(2) Testing charges shall be payable as follows:

Cattle—	
For each animal up to 10	3.00
For each additional animal over 10 the property of the same owner	3.00
Plus blue tongue test if required each animal	40.00
Plus probang test (if required)	35.00
Swine—	
For each animal up to 10	1.00
For each additional animal over 10 the property of the same owner	1.00
Horses, asses, mules, sheep, goats, and dogs—	
The costs of any tests or examinations on these animals required to be carried out at the direction of the Director-General or Chief Veterinary Officer shall be charged to the importer at the actual costs of the service at the time.	

(3) Dipping charges shall be payable as follows:

For one sheep	1.50
For each additional sheep the property of the owner	0.50"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the fees payable in respect of the transport, sustenance, care, testing, and dipping of animals imported into New Zealand.
