ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of August 1975

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. New charge for blue tongue test—Regulation 3 (2) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “40.00” where it appears in the item beginning with the word “Cattle”, and substituting the expression “7.00”.

3. Partial refund of blue tongue test charges—Where cattle have been tested for blue tongue by the complement fixation testing procedure and a charge of \$40 per animal has been paid by a person for such testing pursuant to the principal regulations, the sum of \$33 for each such animal shall be repaid to that person.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the charge for blue tongue tests on cattle from \$40 per animal to \$7 per animal. The reduction in this charge is due to the introduction of a different testing procedure.

These regulations also provide for partial refunds to be made to persons who have paid charges at the rate of \$40 per animal in respect of cattle which have been tested by the new procedure.
