FEES REGULATIONS 1976, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1976, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Animals Quarantine and Import Inspection Fees Regulations 1976* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1982.

2. Fees in respect of animal products, etc.—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 5, the following regulation:

“5A. Fees, in respect of any animal product (including animal manure) introduced into New Zealand and any vehicle, conveyance, fitting, or article of any kind which may have come into contact with any such animal product, shall be payable as follows:

“(a) For fumigation or other treatment—			
Consignment of up to 1 m ³	No fee
Where consignment is more than 1 m ³ , each	0.5 m ³ or part thereof up to 3 m ³	\$7.60
Each 0.5 m ³ or part thereof in excess of 3 m ³ ...			\$4.70
“(b) For the destruction of a consignment or part consignment—			
Where consignment or part to be destroyed does	not exceed 1 m ³	No fee
Where such consignment or part exceeds 1 m ³ ,	each 0.5 m ³ or part thereof	\$2.40”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the fees payable for the fumigation or other treatment, or the destruction of, certain animal products introduced into New Zealand.
