**THE ARMS REGULATIONS 1931, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 27th day of  
June, 1951

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Arms Act, 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Arms Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Arms Regulations 1931\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1951.

2. The Arms Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the following Schedule:—
